



### **UPDATES - Division of Public Health**

<u>Click here to view</u> the updated Emergency Declaration with regard to restaurants, bars and taverns. The DPH has also created a sign that can be used to for businesses to demonstrate their status (open, takeout, and/or delivery). These can be placed on doors and any public-facing areas.



#### Restaurants, Bars and Taverns Should:

- Limit services to take-out, drive through and delivery services <u>only</u> to help prevent the spread of coronavirus; AND
- Use the Restaurants/bars/taverns Modified Emergency Declaration Poster to post the services being provided at your establishment in a place visible from outside the establishment; AND
- Use the restrictions imposed under the modified emergency declaration as a time to safely clean and disinfect all high touch surfaces in the establishments.



As part of Governor Carney's UPDATED Emergency Declaration (3/16/2020), which relates to Restaurants/bars/taverns, we are:

Closed.
 Offering take-out or drive-thru services.
 Offering call-in orders and delivery.

**Delaware Division of Unemployment Insurance** Frequently Asked Questions Regarding the Potential Impact of the coronavirus [COVID-19]

#### WILL WORKERS QUALIFY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS IF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) CAUSES AN EMPLOYER TO SLOW DOWN OR CEASE OPERATIONS?

Answer: Unemployment benefits are available to individuals who are unemployed through no fault of their own. If an employer must shut down operations and no work is available, individuals may be eligible for unemployment benefits if they meet the monetary criteria and the federal weekly eligibility criteria. Claimants who are working reduced hours may be eligible and must report their gross wages at the time they are earned, not paid.



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#### IF AN EMPLOYEE WITHOUT SYMPTOMS DECIDES TO SELF-QUARANTINE BECAUSE OF THE CORONAVIRUS, WILL THEY BE ELIGIBLE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS?

Answer: In most cases, no. Unemployment benefits are available to individuals who are totally or partially unemployed due to no fault of their own. In this example, the individual—not the employer—is choosing not to work and, therefore, would be ineligible. However, the facts of each circumstance are important. If the employer allowed this individual to telework, they would not qualify for benefits because they would not be unemployed. If the employer required the individual to stay home but did not offer telework, the individual might be eligible for benefits if they met the monetary and weekly eligibility criteria. Each claim must be investigated after it is filed.



#### IF AN EMPLOYEE IS IN MANDATORY QUARANTINE BECAUSE OF SUSPICION OF HAVING THE CORONAVIRUS, WILL THEY BE ELIGIBLE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS?

Answer: They might meet the initial eligibility criteria but not the ongoing federal eligibility criteria, which require them to be able to work, available for work, and actively seeking suitable work and would not be eligible for benefits.

Please encourage your employees/coworkers to start an online claim ASAP. Benefits may be available as early as next week, if claims are started this week with expedited approval. Please visit the UI site to register today.
