

Delaware Unemployment Reports Rate Continues Steady Drop

The Delaware Department of Labor in March reported a drop in the state unemployment rate from 4.4 percent to 4.3 percent.

The rate held at 4.5 percent from November 2017 to January 2018, before ticking down to 4.4 percent in February.

The national average has settled at 4.1 percent for the past six months.

The monthly report also found that the total number of unemployed (20,695) dropped six percent from February. The total number of employees stood at 459,564, up 1 percent from last month.

Service industry, health care dominate list of most in-demand jobs.

SmartAsset, a personal finance website and service provider, ranked the top 10 most in-demand jobs.

The list is based on four economic metrics: growth in employment from 2015-2016, percent change in average incomes from 2015-2016, expected growth between 2016-2026, and expected percent change between 2016-2026.

Here are the results: 1. Personal care aides; 2. Food preparation and serving workers, including fast food; 3. Postsecondary health specialties teachers; 4. Nurse practitioners; 5. Non-farm animal caretakers; 6. Restaurant cooks; 7. Medical and health services managers; 8. Information security analysts; 9. Financial managers; 10. Medical assistants.

Out of the top ten, there were a wide range of incomes. Half had average salaries of \$96,000, and other half made under \$32,580 per year. The service industry and health-care professions made up the majority of the list.



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

HB409 SYNOPSIS: ACT TO AMEND TITLE 19 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE DELAWARE WORKER ADJUSTMENT AND RETRAINING NOTIFICATION ACT

This Act creates a state mass layoff and plant closing notice requirement law that requires certain larger employers to provide their employees with adequate notice when they plan to go out of business, close a plant, or lay off a large number of employees. This Act requires employers to also notify the Department of planned mass layoffs and plant closings, so the Department can provide dislocated workers with services to assist them in returning to work as soon as possible. This Act imposes greater notice requirements on employers than the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining

Notification Act ("WARN Act"). This Act authorizes the Department of Labor to investigate violations, conduct administrative hearings for employers who are alleged to have violated this Act, and pursue penalties for failure of an employer to comply with the notice requirements to its employees.

Status: Attorney's looking at . . Questions unanswered on number of days required to advise employees . . . as well as if the change applies to all employees i.e. temporary, seasonal, part-time, etc.

SB91 SYNOPSIS: ACT TO AMEND TITLE 16 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTION DEVICES.

This Act creates a requirement that lodging establishments with an appliance that emits carbon monoxide or an attached garage have working carbon monoxide detection devices in each dwelling or sleeping unit.

This Substitute Bill differs from Senate Bill No. 91 as follows:

- 1. It clarifies that the requirements of this chapter do not apply to a private residence that is occupied by the owner if no dwelling or sleeping units are available for pay.
- 2. It clarifies the definition of owner so that it includes artificial entities that own or actively manage a lodging establishment but does not include an equitable interest in an artificial entity that is an owner.
- 3. It changes the requirements for carbon monoxide detection device installation so that the requirements are essentially the same as the requirements for smoke detectors in Chapter 66 of Title 16.
- 4. It incorporates the changes in Senate Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 91, including the effective dates for compliance.
- 5. It provides the State Fire Marshal authority promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this chapter.
- 6. It makes this Act effective on January 1, 2019.
- 7. It makes technical corrections to conform to the standards of the Delaware Legislative Drafting Manual.

CITY OF REHOBOTH BEACH & STATE UPDATE

TRANSIT UPDATE

City of Rehoboth Beach Commissioners continue to discuss "Public" Transit Drop Off & Pick Up locations. Private motor coach operations will now be required to pick up & drop off at the City Hall location.

DART has requested approval to utilize the area in front of the Bandstand as opposed to the Boardwalk side of the Bandstand to ensure the pubic has a consistent location for both pick up & drop off passengers.

Currently, the Bandstand activities can cause a shift in the pick up & drop off locations.

FROM THE STATE

The Delaware Transit Corporation will offer summer bus parking for tour and bus operators at DARTS' Rehoboth Park and Ride, which will include a discounted rate of \$20 per day (an increase from \$10 last year) and a free Public Transit pass for the bus driver.

The early weekend start-up began on May 5th; the Rehoboth Park and Ride opened on Saturdays and Sundays with bus service from 10 AM to 11 PM. Daily service begins May 21 through September 9th. After the end of the 2018 beach bus season, the Rehoboth Park and Ride will remain open with free parking to accommodate some new, year-round service.

Starting in September, the DTC will add year-round service to Route 201 between Lewes Transit Center, Rehoboth Park and Ride, and Rehoboth Boardwalk; and Route 204 from Lewes Transit Center into Downtown Lewes and the Ferry Terminal.

Parking: From amenity to necessity

While real estate agents will tell you location is everything, downtown merchants in Middletown might tell you it's parking. It is the biggest complaint, next to traffic, from merchants and shoppers alike. At the nearby Westown shopping center that sports such large box stores as Kohl's and Walmart, several people, many who were not from Middletown, said they don't go downtown to shop because of the traffic and parking.

Parking in front of his new store in Westown, Vino Vita at Frommage, was one of the reasons Chris Pride moved his cheese shop from Main Street. He said many of his clients were shopping for a specific cheese. They would tell him that they would decide against the purchase, not because they didn't want the cheese, but because they didn't want the hassle of having to find parking and then walking to the store for a five-minute purchase. Westown just fit his business model better. His store front was snapped up by a Mediterranean deli that is doing well. In the evening, people park at the church lot on Main Street to grab a meal or to attend shows at Everett Theatre.

Despite traffic and parking, storefronts are filling and more people are finding their way downtown, said Mayor Kenneth L. Branner Jr. He sees the two shopping centers helping each other with new business and believes, as many do, that traffic through Main Street will get better once the U.S 301 bypass is completed.
