BRAG BOARD

Bill Signing Ceremony

Governor John Carney, sponsors Sen. Stephanie Hansen, Sen. Ernie Lopez, Speaker Pete Schwartzkopf and Rep. Deb Heffernan, other Members of the General Assembly, coastal town mayors, small business owners, supporters and advocates where present on Thursday, September 20th, 11:00 a.m., as Governor Carney signed Senate Bill 200 and SS1 for Senate Bill 207 into law at the Rehoboth Beach Bandstand in downtown Rehoboth.

Senate Bill 200 prohibits drilling for oil or natural gas in Delaware's coastal zone and territorial waters and precludes DNREC from issuing any permits in connection with the development of offshore drilling infrastructure, whether proposed for Delaware territorial waters or waters outside the state. Senate Substitute #1 for Senate Bill 207 as amended by Senate Amendment #1 opposes drilling off Delaware's coast and directs certain state officials and state agencies to enforce Delaware's rights relating to offshore drilling under federal and state environmental laws.





The US unemployment rate was 3.9% in August 2018, unchanged from July 2018. In August 2017 the US unemployment rate was 4.4%, while Delaware's rate was 4.6%.



- Parking will be free at the following DART Park & Ride locations:

- Transportation available on Saturday, October 27th from 7AM to 11PM.
- Riders pay \$2.00 for a one-way ride; \$4.20 for a full day pass. Download DART Pass to easily purchase your fare using your phone for quick boarding.
- Pick-up and drop-off location for festival goers will be at Lake Ave by the Henlopen Hotel at the Boardwalk.

If travelling from the South, use Jolly Trolley!

- Parking will be free at Tower Road (Oceanside), Delaware Seashore State Park.
- Roundtrip, continuous shuttles on Saturday, October 27th from 8AM to 8PM.
- Stops located at Original Jolly Trolley Stops in Mid-Dewey Beach and anywhere along event route.
- Adults \$3.00 one-way or \$5.00 roundtrip; Kids 5 years and under \$1.00 each way.
- Pick-up and drop-off location for festival goers will be at Lake Ave by the Henlopen Hotel at the Boardwalk.

FULL PARADE ROUTE. The walkers will lead the parade from 4th Street and enter Rehoboth Avenue headed west to State Street then turn left on Rehoboth Avenue headed east and then turn at the Bandstand to return to 4th Street. Motorized vehicles join & follow the walkers on the parade route at State Street.

COSTUME WALKING PARADE REGISTRATION AND LINE-UP. Costumed public is welcome to enter the walking section of the Parade and Costume Contest. The parade is donation based. MOTORIZED/FLOATS/ROLLING PARADE PARTICIPATION. With limited available space for the line up at State Street, there is a limit of 50 pre-registered rolling/motorized vehicles. Many requests to be in the parade have not been accepted in order to alleviate a back-up onto Route One.

PARADE ON TV! The costume parade will be televised live on Saturday, October 27th beginning at 10:30AM on WRDE NBC Coast TV. The parade will re-broadcast on Saturday at 6PM & Sunday at 10AM on COZI TV.

RESTROOMS. Permanent public restrooms are located at the Bandstand & Rehoboth Avenue, the Boardwalk & Baltimore Avenue, the Boardwalk & Delaware Avenue, and Grove Park. Mobile restrooms are located at the El Jefe Gordo restaurant parking lot, 251 Rehoboth Avenue on Saturday only from 8AM until the end of the costume parade.
