LEGISLATIVE ISSUES on the RADAR SCREEN

STATE

Minimum Wage Proposed Increase - Senate Bill 6 - Chamber Opposes. Worker's Compensation - Under Review - Chamber Opposes.

FEDERAL:

Proposed Internet Sales Tax - As we currently understand it, Delaware would be a loser on this one. If you sell an item from Delaware to someone in a tax collecting state then the business must not only collect that state's tax but get it distributed back to them...an administrative nightmare. If you live in Delaware and buy in a tax collecting state you pay no tax. Out of state would not receive any additional revenue return because we are not a tax state. You can see more information at werherecoalition.org.

Obama Care - Enforcement Calculations - 2014 law becomes effective - uses this year's 2013 calculations. Businesses need strategy to meet requirements. Penalties can be assessed next year based on the decisions you make this year (i.e. # of employees/hours worked, etc.). It is our understanding that foreign students are in the calculations.






