Some of these are supposedly from FedEx, USP and Amazon, claiming they are validating an order placed through the website contact e-mail. They all contain attachments for “receipts” or tracking numbers – these are scams.

PUBLIC WORKSHOP – JUNCTION AND BREAKWATER TRAIL EXTENSION – REHOBOTH AVENUE

The Delaware Dept. of Transportation, in conjunction with the City of Rehoboth Beach, invites the public to a workshop on December 14, 2016 from 4:00 – 7:00 PM at the Rehoboth Beach Fire Hall, 219 Rehoboth Avenue, 2nd Floor Meeting Room, to review and comment on a proposed multi-use trail connecting the existing Junction and Breakwater Trail into Rehoboth Beach, along Rehoboth Avenue, and around Grove Park to Henlopen Avenue. This project will include a new 10’ wide multi-use pathway, crosswalks, and curb ramps and will also provide an update on the project’s schedule. Interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for, or in opposition to, the proposed project.
