For many it is hard to be in business right now. Best Advice: BRACE YOURSELF FOR TOMORROW.

Senator Tom Carper spoke to over 70 Chamber Members on February 23rd at Kings Creek Country Club in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. Synopsis of some of the questions asked by members include:

Q: Many of the businesses are holding back from hiring because they are worried about still being in business 12 months from now . . . what answers do elected officials have for us?

A: The economy is recovering, but it is slow growth.

Q: I was advised at a recent meeting that there is a \$500 per employee policy insurance tax scheduled to be levied in 2014 by the Federal government through the insurance industry. As the owner of two restaurants, I and other business owners need to know if this fee is going to be passed down to the businesses to pay? We know the insurance companies will pass this tax to small business. Small business will have to decide whether to pass it to their employees.

A: There is legislation scheduled to go into effect in 2014, with shared expense by the pharmaceutical industry and insurance industry. The individual business is part of the expense (fee) structure.

Additional comments by Senator Carper:

- Do more of what works & less of what doesn't work.
- Continues to see a strong need for becoming less dependent on energy sources from other countries.
- Supports the building of nuclear power plants.






