



PROPOSED INTERNET SALES TAX

March 26, 2013

Dear Senator Carper, Senator Coons and Representative Carney:

It is our understanding that a federal proposed internet sales tax is being discussed. The Rehoboth Beach-Dewey Beach Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, which represents 1,300 members, has concerns over the implications of such a tax on the business community. Under the current proposal, if a business sells an item from Delaware to someone in a tax collecting state, the Delaware business must not only collect the other state's tax but also distribute the revenue back to them. This would create an administrative nightmare for many businesses.

Based on the information we have at hand, the proposed starting point for taxing internet sales would begin at one million dollars. This amount may seem to give a benefit to small business and only apply to the larger corporate internet sales kings, i.e., Amazon.com, Overstock.com, etc. In reality, the starting point of one million dollars in total sales is too low in today's world. If the starting point began at 3 million dollars or more, it would protect many small businesses from this tax.

We have additional concerns that, as proposed, the internet sales tax might also encourage the creation of an internet or other sales tax in Delaware.

The Rehoboth Beach-Dewey Beach Chamber of Commerce is asking you to provide us with information about this proposed tax and advise us of your position on this matter. Thank you for your time and consideration.




