Andy Stayton ... Happy Retirement!



The Board of Directors and Chamber Staff would like to thank retiring and long time Chamber Legislative Consultant **Andy Stayton** for his representation of the Chamber and it's Members at Legislative Hall. As of July 2013, Andy is happily enjoying retirement!

Andy, a native Delawarean was born in Lewes. He moved to Newark, Delaware in 1954 and graduated from Newark High School and the University of Delaware with a Business Degree. In 1967, he married his high school sweetheart Lauren and they have two daughters and five grandchildren. Andy served in the Delaware National Guard for six years and joined the Delaware State Police (DSP) in January of 1969. His career included serving in a number of positions ranging from

patrol, training officer, Accident Invest Specialist and four years as the officer in charge of Governor Pete du Pont's Executive Security Force (77-81). The last seven years of his career were served at DSP Headquarters as Deputy and then Section Chief of the Traffic Section. While there, Mr. Stayton developed the DUI Check Point system that has helped change the driving habits of many drinking drivers.

After retiring from the DSP, he joined the Delaware State Chamber of Commerce as Vice President of Government Relations. For ten years, Andy represented the business community at the Delaware General Assembly and he formed his own lobbying business, Legislative Consulting, Inc. in 1998. One of his initial clients was the Rehoboth Beach – Dewey Beach Chamber of Commerce. In addition to advocating for the Chamber, two of his proudest accomplishments as a private lobbyist were working with others to pass the Clean Indoor Air Act and the Primary Seatbelt Law.

After living in Newark for 57 years, Andy and Lauren moved to Rehoboth Beach last June. They enjoy frequent visits with their daughters and grandchildren who live in Newark and nearby Westminster, Maryland.

Andy will be recognized for his service at the Annual Volunteer Recognition & Officers' Installation Dinner on Thursday, January 23, 2014.
