

ENJOY A BREATH OF FRESH AIR

The new City of Rehoboth Beach ordinance regulating smoking in outdoor public areas went into effect on May 15, 2014. There will be more smoke-free areas in the City of Rehoboth Beach where the burning of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other matter or substance that contains tobacco is prohibited on a year round basis.

The following areas are now designated as being smoke-free: Parks & Children's Playgrounds, Bandstand Plaza, Boardwalk and Accessways, Beach* and Dune Crossings (*except for designated smoking areas on the beach).
